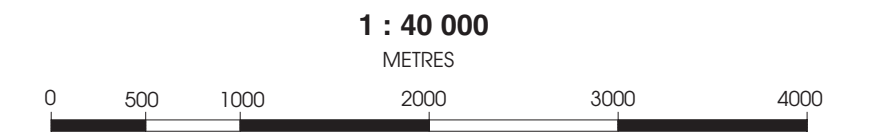

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ELECTORAL DISTRICT OF PUMICESTONE
Commencing at the mouth of the Caboolture River at its confluence with Deception Bay and bounded thence by that river upwards to Elison Road, by that road, Bellmere Road and Bells Lane northerly, easterly and north-westerly to South Waraba Creek, by that creek downwards and Waraba Creek upwards to the eastern boundary of Lot 245 on CG1940, by that boundary and Devantier Road northerly to the D'Aguilar Highway, by that highway south-easterly and generally easterly to the Bruce Highway, by that highway northerly to the northern boundary of the Moreton Bay Regional Council, by that boundary generally easterly to Glass Mountain Creek, by that creek downwards to the Pumicestone Channel, by that channel generally northerly and south-easterly to again the northern boundary of the Moreton Bay Regional Council; and by that boundary and the eastern boundary of that council north-easterly, south-easterly, generally westerly and south-westerly to the point of commencement.
