- so nearly resembles a party name that it is likely to be confused with or mistaken for the party name; or
- includes the word 'independent'; or
- would otherwise be likely to cause confusion if registered.

ECQ may refuse to register a political party if the party's name and/or abbreviation:

- is a public body name; or
- so nearly resembles a public body name that it is likely to be confused with or mistaken for the public body name.
