Ballots Issued

313 members were eligible to vote.

1252 ballot papers with declaration envelopes were issued to eligible members.

14 members were re-issued ballot material.

Ballots Returned

217 declaration envelopes were returned to the ECQ.

2 did not proceed to the vote count as the ballot papers were returned outside of the declaration envelope.

215 declaration envelopes proceeded to the roll mark-off.
