To the Electoral Commission of Queensland

I, Jeannette Rosita Young AC PSM, Governor -

- (i) direct that you proceed according to the law to an election of a Member of the Legislative Assembly of Queensland for the Electoral District of Stafford;
- (ii) appoint -

Friday, the seventeenth day of April 2026 to be the day of issue of this Writ;
Tuesday, the twenty-first day of April 2026 to be the cut-off day for electoral rolls for the election;

Friday, the twenty-fourth day of April 2026 to be the cut-off day for the nomination of candidates for the election;

Saturday, the sixteenth day of May 2026 to be the polling day; and
Thursday, the ninth day of July 2026 for the return of this Writ.


