



Application to Deregister a Group of Candidates

The *Local Government Electoral Act 2011* allows candidates to form a group to contest an election. After an election, a group of candidates may wish to deregister their group. This form can be completed to apply to the ECQ to have a local government group deregistered and must be submitted by a member of the group. This form can also be submitted online through the Election Management System, available at www.ecq.qld.gov.au.

Lodgement timeframe

Groups can apply to deregister a group at any time after an election. However, the ECQ will only deregister a group when:

- All disclosure obligations required by the *Local Government Electoral Act 2011* have been completed; and
- Any money in the group’s dedicated campaign bank account has been paid to a charity or a political party (of which all candidates in the group are members), and a bank statement has been provided to confirm a nil balance.
