

Electronically Assisted (Telephone) Voting Notice  
**CALLIDE STATE BY-ELECTION**  
**SATURDAY, 18 JUNE 2022**

The Callide State by-election will be held on Saturday, 18 June 2022. **Voting is compulsory.**

This notice identifies the classes of electors who, under section 121A of the *Electoral Act 1992* and 4AA of the *Electoral Regulation 2013*, may make an electronically assisted vote (telephone vote) at the 2022 Callide State by-election.

**Electors who are eligible to use telephone voting for this by-election include:**

- electors who cannot vote without assistance due to an impairment or an insufficient level of literacy
- electors who cannot vote at a polling booth because of an impairment
  - this includes electors who, during the by-election period, cannot attend a polling place as they have been diagnosed with COVID-19 and must isolate under a direction issued under section 362B of the *Public Health Act 2005*
- special postal voters who are not detained in lawful custody
- distance voters whose enrolled address is more than 20km from a polling booth, and
- electors who cannot vote at a polling booth during the voting period for the by-election
  - this includes electors located interstate or overseas.
