

# Resignation as Agent of a Group of Candidates

The Local Government Electoral Act 2011 (LGEA) allows candidates to form a group to contest an election. Groups are required to appoint an agent to take responsibility for ensuring compliance with the group's disclosure obligations under the LGEA. This form can be completed by the agent, in the event they wish to resign their appointment. This form can also be submitted online through the Election Management System, available at www.ecq.qld.gov.au.

If a person is also resigning as a candidate member of the group, the group must also complete Form QLG05B.

### Lodgement timeframe

An agent can resign at any time without the consent of the candidates in the group.
