After a state general election or by-election, the registered officer of each registered political party must notify the ECQ whether the selection of candidates endorsed by the party for the election involved a preselection ballot.

A preselection ballot is defined under the *Electoral Act 1992* as:

- (a) the process, or that part of the process, of selecting a candidate to be endorsed by a political party for an election, or an election for a local government, in which a member of the party votes in a ballot in his or her capacity as a member of the party, rather than as a member of a committee (however called) of the party, for the candidate; and
- (b) includes matter preparatory to the ballot and the scrutiny and counting of votes in the ballot.

Lodgement timeframe

The registered officer must notify the ECQ of any preselection ballots undertaken for an election within 30 days of polling day for the election.
