2020 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS: POSTAL VOTING/ ELECTION DAY VOTING

Postal voting

There were over 570,000 postal vote applications for the 2020 local government elections.

All postal vote applications received by the ECQ prior to the deadline of 7pm on 16 March, have been processed and all postal ballot material has been posted.

Postal votes must be completed by 6pm on election day (Saturday, 28 March 2020) and the ECQ must receive completed ballots no later than 5pm Tuesday, 7 April 2020.

If you do not receive your postal ballot material, you can still cast your vote in person. Polling booth information can be found at <u>ecq.qld.gov</u> and <u>here</u>.

Election day voting

Election day voting is between 8am and 6pm, Saturday 28 March.

You must vote in your local government area.

If you received a voter information card either via email or in the post, take this with you when you vote. This will assist in the electoral roll mark-off process.

If you are unable to vote in person and receive an Apparent Failure to Vote Notice for this election from the ECQ please make reference to your attempt to postal vote in the applicable area on the form.
