Candidate Notes

Nominations open at midday on Tuesday, 10 March 2026. Nominations must be in writing, comply with the rules of the Union, and **be received by the Electoral Commission of Queensland (ECQ) no later than midday on Thursday, 9 April 2026.**

Candidates for election for President, Vice President and Secretary/Treasurer must be eligible executive members of the Union assigned to or stationed at a police establishment not more than 240km by road from the General Post Office in Brisbane. Candidates for election for Executive Member, must be eligible executive members, of which, a minimum of four members must be assigned to or stationed at a police establishment not more than 240km by road from the General Post Office in Brisbane.

Nominations close at midday on Thursday, 9 April 2026

Nominations may be received by hand delivery, post or email and must include the signature of the nominee. Nominees should ensure that their nomination is received by the ECQ and can be clearly read. A nomination form is included with this notice. Additional forms can be obtained from the Union or the ECQ's website; www.ecq.qld.gov.au.

Candidates wishing to withdraw their nomination may do so by written notice to the ECQ no later than seven (7) days after nominations close.

Ballot

Should a ballot be necessary, the ECQ will conduct a secret postal ballot of eligible members. The ballot will **open on Tuesday, 28 April 2026** and **close at midday on Tuesday, 2 June 2026.**

The roll of voters will be prepared following the close of nominations, To be eligible to vote a member must be a financial member of the Union thirty (30) days before nominations open.

Ballots are decided by a first-past-the-post system of voting.
