



*For candidates*

The *Electoral Act 1992* requires a candidate to keep a State campaign account that is a bank account solely used for all electoral expenditure, gifts, loans, and political donations.

If details of the State campaign account change, the appointed agent **MUST** notify the ECQ of the change.

## Lodgement timeframe

Changes to a State campaign account must be submitted **within 5 business days**.
