

State campaign account details

For candidates

The *Electoral Act 1992* requires a candidate to keep a State campaign account that is a bank account solely used for all electoral expenditure, gifts, loans, and political donations.

If details of the State campaign account change, the appointed agent MUST notify the ECQ of the change.

Lodgement timeframe

Changes to a State campaign account must be submitted within 5 business days.
