

## Appointment of an agent for a registered political party

A registered political party must appoint an agent, who is responsible for the party's election funding and financial disclosure obligations.

A party can appoint ONE agent to represent it.

The appointment of an agent takes effect when the person's name is entered in the ECQ's register of agents.

During any period where no agent is appointed, EACH MEMBER of the executive committee of the registered political party becomes accountable for the obligations and responsibilities of the agent until such time as a new agent is appointed.

### Lodgement timeframe

An agent must be appointed when a political party is first registered.

If a person's appointment as the agent of a political party ends, a new agent must be appointed within 28 days.
