

Endorsement of a candidate for a State election Commission

by a registered political party

A registered political party must notify the ECQ when:

- a) the party endorses a person to be a candidate in an election; or
- b) the party proposes to endorse a person to be a candidate in an election by publicly announcing the party's intention to endorse the person as a candidate for the election or starts to incur electoral expenditure for the benefit of the person as a candidate for the election; or
- c) the party's endorsement or proposed endorsement of the person changes before the polling day for the election.

The ECQ must be notified of the endorsement by the registered political party within 7 days.

The ECQ will notify the person endorsed as a candidate as soon as practicable on receipt of notification from the registered political party.

Details of the endorsed candidate's State campaign bank account must be provided to the ECQ within 5 business days.

Lodgement timeframe

Registered political parties must notify the ECQ within 7 days.
