



# Appointment of an agent for a candidate

A candidate may appoint an agent for a State election, who is responsible for the candidate’s election funding and financial disclosure obligations. A candidate may only appoint ONE agent to represent them.

The appointment of an agent takes effect when the person’s name is entered in the ECQ’s register of agents.

During any period where no agent is appointed, the CANDIDATE becomes accountable for the obligations and responsibilities carried out by the agent until such time as a new agent is appointed.

## Lodgement timeframe

An agent may be appointed by a candidate at any time.
