

# WANT TO WORK AT AN ELECTION?

**The Stretton State by-election will be held on Saturday, 24 July 2021.**

The ECQ employs temporary election staff to work before, on, or after election day. There are many positions available for people from a range of backgrounds and experiences.

## Who do we hire?

To work at an election, you need to be on the electoral roll (but you don't have to be enrolled in Stretton) and be 16 years or older.

The ECQ encourages applications from a wide range of people including those who:

- have never worked at an election
- speak English well but also speak another language/s
- are living with a disability
- are of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent.
