**Postal Ballot**

The postal ballot for State Council Representative of the Maroochydore Branch opened, Wednesday, 2 October 2019 and closed at midday on Thursday, 24 October 2019.

**Ballots issued**

493 members were eligible to vote.

493 ballot papers with declaration envelopes were issued to eligible members.

4 ballot papers with declaration envelopes were re-issued to members due to the ECQ being notified of a change of address.

**Ballot returned**

99 declaration envelopes were returned to the ECQ.

1 did not proceed to the vote count as it was returned without the signed declaration slip.

1 did not proceed to the vote count as the ballot paper was returned outside the declaration envelope.

A total of 97 declaration envelopes proceeded to the roll mark-off.
