This notice identifies the classes of electors who, under section 121A of the *Electoral Act 1992* and section 6 of the *Electoral Regulation 2024*, may make an electronically assisted vote (telephone vote) at the 2025 Hinchinbrook State by-election.

Those eligible to use telephone voting for this by-election include:

- Electors who cannot vote without assistance due to an impairment or an insufficient level of literacy.
- Electors who cannot vote at a polling booth because of an impairment.
- Special postal voters who are not detained in lawful custody.
- Distance voters whose enrolled address is more than 20km from a polling booth.
- Electors who are not in Queensland at any time during the voting period, including electors located interstate or overseas.
