

# Withdrawal of endorsement of a candidate

By a registered political party

The registered officer of a registered political party must notify the ECQ if:

- a. the political party withdraws the endorsement of a candidate; or
- b. an elected member of Parliament, or an elected councillor (who was elected as an endorsed candidate) ceases being a member of the political party.

The ECQ will notify the candidate or elected member / councillor as soon as practicable after the receipt of the notification of withdrawal of endorsement. If a withdrawal of endorsement occurs after the candidate has been nominated by the political party for an election, and before the close of nominations for an election, then the nomination will be of no effect.

Notifications about withdrawal of endorsement which are received after the close of nominations for an election will not be reflected on the ballot paper for the election.

#### Lodgement timeframe

This form must be submitted as soon as possible after the withdrawal of the endorsement occurs.
