In-person voting services

Early voting

- Early voting centres open Monday, 17 November to Friday, 28 November 2025 (excluding weekends).
- Voters may cast ordinary or declaration votes for the by-election at an early voting centre.

Election day voting

- Polling booths open from 8am to 6pm on election day, Saturday, 29 November 2025.
- Voters may cast ordinary or declaration votes at a polling booth on election day.
