Lodgement timeframe

How-to-vote cards must be lodged no later than 5pm on **the Friday that is 7 days before** the polling day for the state government election.

Note: if a language other than English is printed on a how-to-vote card that is required to be lodged, you must provide a written translation with this form.

It is an offence for a person to distribute, or permit or authorise someone else to distribute, a how-to-vote card on the polling day for the election unless the how-to-vote card and statutory declaration relating to financial contributions have been properly lodged. How-to-vote cards that have not been lodged in accordance with the provisions of the *Electoral Act 1992* must not be distributed.
