### MAPOON ABORIGINAL SHIRE COUNCIL **COUNCILLOR BY-ELECTION SATURDAY 15 APRIL 2023**



On 3 March 2023, a Notice of Election was issued to hold a by-election to fill a vacancy in the office of councillor in the Mapoon Aboriginal Shire Council on 1 April 2023. As no candidate nominations were received for the by-election, the proceedings for the by-election must start again in accordance with section 34(2) of the Local Government Electoral Act 2011.

On 17 March 2023, a Notice of Election was published fixing 15 April 2023 as the new polling day as detailed below.

Polling booths will be open on election day from 8am to 6pm. Voting is compulsory.

#### Candidate nominations are open from Friday, 17 March 2023 and close at 12pm (noon) on Monday, 27 March 2023.

Nominations are invited from those interested in contesting the by-election.

- Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer or through the Electoral Commission of Queensland's (ECQ) website.
